

Events are organised by the Biodiversity Office of Kerry County Council in collaboration with other partners, including:

Tralee Bay Wetlands Centre: A visitor attraction aimed at attracting new overseas and domestic tourists to Tralee and the wider South-West region. The project utilises the rich natural heritage of the Tralee Bay area – wetlands of international importance – to attract visitors to the area.

Killarney National Park Education Centre (KNPEC): is a non-profit making entity, run by the Kerry Education Service and The National Parks and Wildlife Service. The Centre is based in Knockreer House, situated close to the town of Killarney, with spectacular views over the National Park. The ethos of the centre is based on a hands-on approach to learning about nature.

Irish Whale and Dolphin Group (IWDG): is dedicated to the conservation and better understanding of cetaceans (whales, dolphins and porpoises) in Irish waters. The Group was founded in 1990 to establish an Irish stranding and sighting scheme and to campaign for the declaration of Irish territorial waters as a whale and dolphin sanctuary. In June 1991 the Irish Government declared all Irish waters to be a whale and dolphin sanctuary, the first in Europe.

Irish Wildlife Trust (IWT): is a conservation charity committed to raising awareness of Ireland's rich natural heritage and protecting it for future generations. A Kerry Branch is now up and running. See www.iwt.ie for further details.

Swift Conservation Ireland - Mayo Branch: The swift is on the amber list of birds of conservation concern in Ireland because its population has declined by over 40% in the last 15 years. SCI aims to reverse this trend by raising awareness around the bird, its ecology and need for nest sites in our towns and villages.

Team Bramble: is a group of volunteers which works with Tralee Tidy Towns, Tralee Chamber Alliance and Kerry County Council. Team Bramble co-ordinates with schools, businesses and community groups to carry out projects such as litter picks, tree & flower planting, beach cleans and various environmental and biodiversity projects throughout the year.

This is an action of Kerry's Heritage and Biodiversity Plan 2008-2012.
